

We recorded also last week the, death of the Right Rev. Dr. John Gregg, Bishop of Cork, Cloyne, and Ross, in the Protestant Church of Ireland. His portrait is likewise now engraved for this publication. He was the son of a country gentleman in the county of Clare, and nephew of the late Right Hon. James Fitzgerald. He was educated at Trinity College, Dublin, held several appointments as a clergyman, was made Archdeacon of Kildare in 1857, and Bishop of Cork in 1862. His second son is the Right Rev. Dr. Samuel Gregg, Bishop of Ossory since 1875. The late Bishop of Cork was in the eightieth year of his age.
